

You will need:

- cardboard tube
- construction paper
- yarn or string
- crepe paper or tissue paper
- markers
- glue or glue stick
- hole punch

In Japan, May 5 is Children's Day.

One way people celebrate is to fly traditional carp wind socks, or Koinobori, outside their houses.

- 1 Glue construction paper around a cardboard tube.
- 2 Punch 2 holes across from each other in one end of the tube.
- 3 Thread a piece of yarn through the holes and tie the ends together.
- 4 Decorate your koinobori with markers and cut paper.
- 5 Glue strips of crepe paper or tissue paper inside the tube.
- 6 Use the yarn to hang your creation up and watch it fly!
